



LINK RECORD APPROACH

An abbreviated MARC (or MARC-like) record called the *link record* contains the cluster of successive titles, presented with a label such as **Published under title:** These titles are also hotlinks linked (preferably by control number) to their respective bib records, and the link record is linked as well to a cluster of holdings records. In each holdings record, the holdings of the successive titles are combined, but each format has a separate holdings record. Any search for holdings for any of the connected titles presents, through the link record, the entire cluster of holdings records. Within the holdings records, the subfield ≠3 technique may be used to group holdings, displaying a particular title and date or range of dates.
