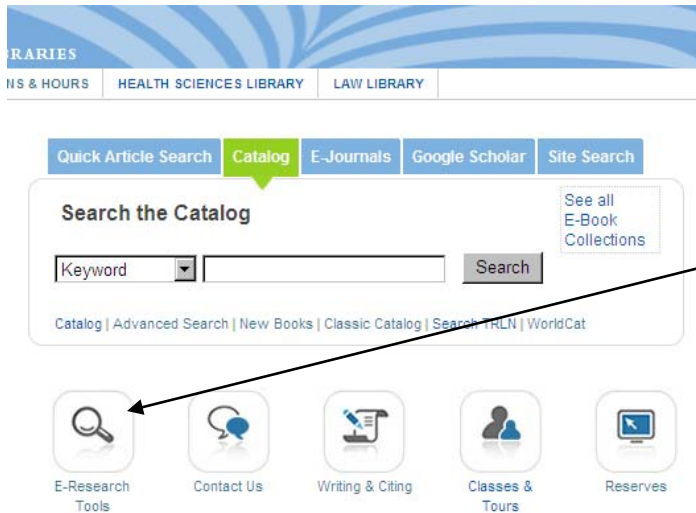

## Art & Art History

### 1 Search an Online Index



Access article databases (also called "online indexes") in the **E-RESEARCH TOOLS** portion of the library homepage ([www.lib.unc.edu](http://www.lib.unc.edu))



From the E-RESEARCH TOOLS page, locate online indexes by subject or by title.

Here is a list of **library-provided indexes and other databases** that provide citations to articles on ART & ART HISTORY topics:

- **Art Full Text:** 1929 (abstracts from 1984) – present. Over 200 international publications on art and art history are indexed monthly.
- **Art Index Retrospective:** 1974 – present. Updated biannually.
- **Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals:** 1741 – present. Surveys more than 2,500 US and foreign journals.
- **Bibliography of the History of Art (BHA):** 1973 - present. Over 2,500 periodicals, art-related books, conference proceedings and dissertations, exhibition and dealer's catalogs are indexed quarterly.
- **Oxford Art Online (full-text):** Includes the Grove Dictionary of Art, with over 45,000 full-text and signed articles covering a vast range of art topics from prehistory through the present. (Also available in print: N31 D5 1996 Art Lib Reference)
- **Index to Art Periodicals (Ryerson Library, Art Institute of Chicago):** Print index published in 1962. Includes periodicals from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century and early 20<sup>th</sup> century not included in the other databases. (Z5937 .C55 Art Lib Reference)

**2 Retrieve Articles** When an article is available full-text from one of the online indexes, a link to the full-text will be presented. For instance, as an **HTML document**, or as a **PDF document**.



If neither of these options is presented, click on the **Find article @ UNC** link. This action will open a pop-up window with information about additional options for full-text.

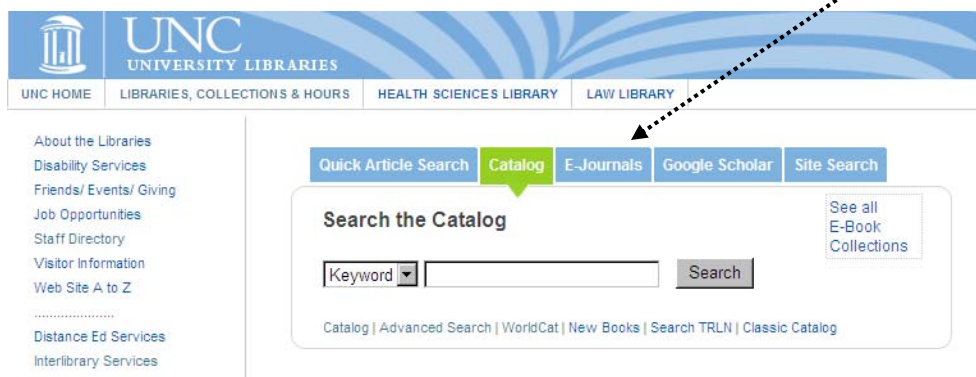
